FLORAL DESIGN COMPETITION SCHEDULE

FLORAL DESIGN CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 1. "Nature's Palette"

- Design to interpret the above theme viewed and judged frontally and must be staged from the floor
- The allotted space is 1mt. square, no height restrictions, but must have a minimum height of 1.5mt
- Exhibit may be staged between 7.30am and 3.00pm on Wednesday 9th July 2025

Prizes: 1st....\$350 2nd....\$250 3rd....\$150

Class 2. "Petals and Pearls" Table for Two

- Design to interpret the above theme to be viewed and judged all around and must be staged on supplied round table. Table will have a black cloth but you may add your own topper or runner.
- Table measurements are 560mm round x 600mm high
- Table settings e.g. plates, cutlery etc. to be supplied by exhibitor
- Allotted space is 600mm
- Tables are décor tables made from MDF so please be aware of weight

Prizes: 1st....\$100 2nd....\$75 3rd....\$50

OPEN SECTIONS

Class 3. "Beauty of the Deep" Sea Creature

- To be viewed and judged all around
- To be staged on a supplied black covered Plinth
- Plinth measures 30cm x 30cm x 90cm
- Dried or fresh horticulture material is acceptable

Class 4. "Sunset Serenade"

- To be viewed and judged from the front
- To be staged on a black covered bench
- Allotted space is 80cm width

Class 5. "Bent But Not Broken"

- To be viewed and judged from the front
- To be staged on a black covered bench
- Allotted space is 80cm width

Class 6. "Vision of Tranquility"

- To be viewed and judged from the front
- To be staged on a black covered bench
- Allotted space is 80cm width

Class 7. "Wintery Moon"

- The exhibit is to be designed to hang in a supplied, rectangle frame, measuring 180cm high x 80cm wide staged with black background
- Horticulture materials must predominate
- To be viewed and judged frontally
- Allotted space is 1m width
